



Attachment 1: Recalls

If asked: Food recall – Inside Out Almond Milk, a case of botulism

- x On the afternoon of 15 February, NSW DPI informed Inside Out Nutritious Goods Pty Ltd and FSANZ that 1 case of botulism had been reported to NSW Health, and that this had been linked to JS Health x Inside Out Almond Milk.
- x Considering the risk to public health and safety, FSANZ worked through the night with Inside Out Nutritious Goods Pty Ltd and NSW DPI to recall the product. The recall was published in the early hours (12:30am AEST) of 16 February.
- x The recall was later expanded on 17 February to include an additional 2 oat milk products from the same company.
- x All 3 products were recalled from Woolworths stores nationally.
- x Botulinum toxin is produced by the bacteria *Clostridium botulinum*. Consumption of food containing botulinum toxin causes serious, sometimes fatal, disease. The illness causes paralysis, including paralysis of the breathing muscles.
