Brief description of Proposal: To review the regulation of kava in the Code to ensure it adequately addresses public health and safety related to the potential increased availability of kava to the wider community.		Potentially affected Standard: 2.6.3

Other comments or Relevant Matters:

On 28 October 2021, Minister Colbeck, as Chair of the Food Ministers' Meeting, requested the Chair of the FSANZ Board to consider preparing a proposal, and then declaring it urgent. If the request is accepted the purpose is to review the Code to ensure it protects public health and safety when the commercial importation of kava into Australia becomes unlimited as part of the Federal Government commitment to the Pacific in December 2021. The intent is to amend the Code to more explicitly limit the preparation of kava beverages to traditional use, and to ensure that food additives and processing aids may not be added to dried or raw kava root or kava beverages. The proposal is only to review kava as a food, not therapeutic or medicinal products or food supplements.
